First, thank you so much for sharing your time and efforts with our students. You are part of the leading edge of something wonderful and I want to let you know how much I appreciate you. Your participation in this is the first step in a long-term plan that is going to put Aiken into the forefront in the southeast as a leader as we grow pickleball into a truly international sport. Many, many people are already involved in this effort, but I wanted to let you know you are truly appreciated.

The following are a few painfully obvious points I want to revisit, but I want to make sure we are all in agreement before we set foot on campus.

- 1. We are volunteers involved in an Aiken County Public School District (ACPSD) program, supervised by a ACPSD personnel. <u>ALL</u> student behavior issues are to be deferred to ACPSD personnel.
- 2. Our task is to aid the ACPSD personnel (and the Lead volunteer pickleball instructor) on communicating best practices for the game of Pickleball.
- 3. These are children and are looking to us for guidance. At a minimum, you MUST:
 - Treat all students with respect
 - Avoid personal cell phones (except 911), misconduct, or inappropriate language
 - Allow ACPSD staff apply discipline, not us
 - Avoid physical contact, except emergency first aid (if you are qualified). Absolutely NO hugs unless the student is your child (The occasional 'high-five' is OK)
 - NEVER work in isolation
- 4. You should:
 - Praise good sportsmanship and performance
 - Be mindful of exceptional skills. Our future superstars are coming from this group
 - Leave valuable personal items in your car
- 5. Take 5 minutes from each session to encourage pre-activity stretches.
- 6. Please review the following areas and communicate them with students:
 - Suitable Footwear
 - Safe footwork or movement (no running backwards)
 - Attire/clothing
- 7. For future interactions (e.g., parents reach out to us)
 - Encourage students to learn and read the rules, including taking the online tests.
 - Encourage students to subscribe to USAP Jr. membership.
